## **FIRE PERMITS**

The fire season has arrived. As of April 1<sup>st</sup> any burning in the Municipality requires a Municipal Fire Permit. The fire season continues until October 31<sup>st</sup>.

The Permittee shall ensure the following:

- Fire is supervised at all times by someone who is at least 18 years of age;
- No fire is left unattended; and
- The permittee assumes full responsibilities.

**\* There is to be absolutely no daytime burning during the fire season. \***

Any person who starts a fire outdoors or is in charge of one, shall ensure the following:

- All conditions will allow the fire to burn safely.
- Steps to keep fire in control will be taken;
- Fire will be extinguished before leaving the site;
- There are sufficient resources available to maintain & control the fire;
- No fire shall be lit until 2 hours before sunset; and
- All fires must be fully out by 2 hours after sunrise.

Municipal Fire Permits are available at the Municipal Office in Balmertown. If you have any questions regarding Municipal Fire Permits, please contact the By-Law Enforcement Officer, at 735-2096, ext. 225.

If you plan to burn outside the Municipality please contact the Ministry of Natural Resources at 727-2000.

**WASTE DISPOSAL BY-LAW**



An amendment was made to By-Law No. 530-04 (Waste Disposal By-Law) at the last regular Council meeting. The following has been added to the Waste Disposal By-Law:

1.3.31 "Bear Resistant" shall mean a container of sturdy metal construction that has a bear resistant latching system on the lid. The container must also be placed in a secured area or have a locking system that cannot be opened without a key or padlock.

6.1.6 No industrial sized metal bins shall be permitted on public or private property unless they are bear resistant.
