DOGS RUNNING AT LARGE

The Municipality of Red Lake's By-Law on the Licensing and
Regulating of Dogs states the following:

No persons shall suffer, allow or permit any dog, of which he/she is
the owner to run at large within the limits of the Municipality of Red
Lake.

For the purposes of this By-Law a dog shall be deemed to be
running at large when found in any place other than the premises of
the owner of the dog and not under the direct control of a
competent person.

A dog shall be deemed not to be under the control of a competent
person when the dog is not on a leash held by the competent
person.

No owner shall suffer, allow, permit his/her dog to trespass on
private property whether on a leash or not.

The set fine for allowing dog(s) to run at large is \$100.00.
The failure of the owner of the dog (s) to license is \$50.00.
