NOTICE OF PASSING OF BY-LAW 752-06

WASTE DISPOSAL BY-LAW



An amendment was made to Section 1.3.31 of By-Law No. 530-04 (Waste Disposal By-Law) at the last Regular Council Meeting. Section 1.3.31 has been amended as follows:

1.3.31 “Bear Resistant” shall mean a fully enclosed metal container with metal lid, which can be completely closed with a latching mechanism that prevents access by bears. Any container which is overfilled so as to prevent latching is not a bear resistant container.
