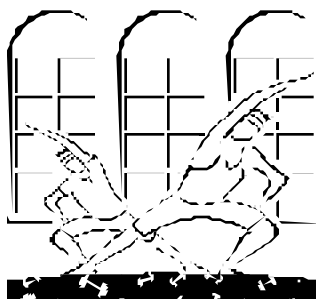

In May 2007 the Heritage Centre will be opening a new exhibit on "Three Centuries of Fur Trading". This exhibit will include a Trading Post with replicas, a timeline on the history of the Fur Trade, profiles of some of the men who enrolled in the service of the Hudson's Bay Company (HBC) along with the man who established the first HBC post in Red Lake in 1790!
