A MESSAGE FROM THE FIRE DEPARTMENT

It's spring again and we have changed our clocks to daylight savings time in mid-March. Have we all remembered to check our smoke alarms with the time change? Possibly, a few have remembered to check these valuable life saving devices.

Have you taken the time to check the alarm on the device? Have you possibly changed the battery? If the battery was replaced a year or more ago, it is time to remove and replace it with a new one.

If the smoke alarm is eight to ten years old, you may want to look at changing the complete unit. These smoke alarms do contain sensitive plates that recognize smoke and heat. If you have done any renovations in your home, dust particles will collect on the plate and decrease the ability to sense smoke and heat situations. If this is the situation in your home, it is time to toss that old unit and replace it with a brand new one. The cost is about \$20 to \$25, but the knowledge of knowing that a new unit is in place, PRICELESS!

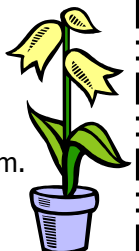
