Council will review the "Request for Proposals" and contact the successful party for further negotiations.

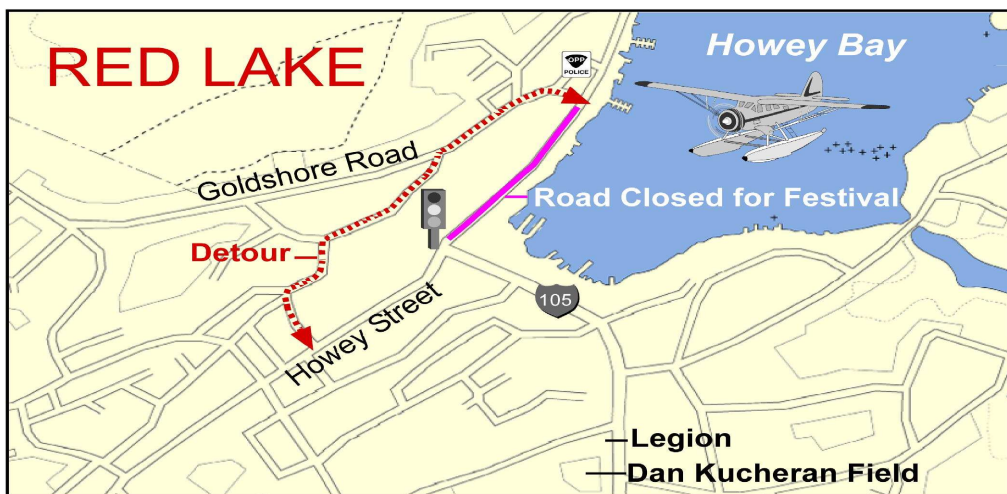
