NOTICE TO ALL TAXPAYERS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF RED LAKE

If you own property in the Municipality of Red Lake, please note that the 2007 Final Bills were mailed the end of July, 2007. The due dates for property taxes covering all classes are as follows:

The first installment is due August 31st, 2007
The second installment is due October 31st, 2007

If you do not receive your tax bill, please contact the Municipal Office at 735-2096, ext. 230. Failure to receive a bill does not absolve a tax payer from responsibility for payment of taxes or penalty/interest charges.

Payments must be received at the Municipal Office on or before the due date. A penalty charge of 1.25% is added for non-payment the day after the due date, and the first day of each month thereafter until paid. Payments may be made by mail, at the CIBC, Lakewood Credit Union or the Bank of Nova Scotia, or by way of Telebanking or Internet banking. They may also be paid at the Municipal Office by way of cash, credit card, Interac or cheque.

NUISANCE BEARS



The Municipality of Red Lake is urging residents to be aware and to work together to avoid attracting nuisance bears.

Nuisance bears don't always have good quality food available. Nuisance animals will eat whatever they can get, including garbage, pet food, birdseed, compost and many other things. They will also return to food sources they remember from the previous years.

To reduce the chances of attracting nuisance bears, the Municipality advises residents to:

- * Deposit waste in containers only on the day of collection.
- * Wash garbage containers frequently and use disinfectant to cut odors.
- * Keep barbeques and picnic tables clean.
- * Remove all birdfeeders.
- * Keep pet food inside the house.
