NOTICE OF A PUBLIC OPEN HOUSE

for a Community Development Plan

Council for the Municipality of Red Lake has initiated a work program to identify lands suitable to accommodate new residential development in the Municipality. This process is guided by the Municipality's new Official Plan, which was approved by the Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing on November 22, 2006.

There are two components to this work program:

- To assess the potential for additional residential development within the current settlement area boundaries of the Red Lake townsites established by the Official Plan; and
- To prepare a future community development plan capable of accommodating long term residential housing needs.

Interested members of the public are welcome to attend an Open House to review and discuss this important community development project. The Open House will be held on **Thursday, September 13th, 2007 from 2 to 4 pm and 6 to 8 pm** at the Municipal Office in Balmertown. The Municipality's Planning Staff and Consultant will attend the Open House and will have mapping and development concepts available for review.

DOGS RUNNING AT LARGE



The Municipality of Red Lake's By-Law on the Licensing and Regulating of Dogs states the following:

No persons shall suffer, allow or permit any dog, of which he/she is the owner to run at large within the limits of the Municipality of Red Lake.

For the purposes of this By-Law a dog shall be deemed to be running at large when found in any place other than the premises of the owner of the dog and not under the direct control of a competent person.

A dog shall be deemed not to be under the control of a competent person when the dog is not on a leash held by the competent person.

No owner shall suffer, allow, permit his/her dog to trespass on private property whether on a leash or not.

The set fines for allowing dog(s) to run at large is \$100.00.
The failure of the owner of the dog (s) to license is \$50.00.

FIRE PERMITS

Please be advised that fire permits are required until October 31st, 2006. Permits cost \$5.00 and may be picked up at the Municipal Office in Balmertown.
