THE GREAT REFRIGERATOR ROUNDUP PROGRAM

The Great Refrigerator Roundup program, a new energy conservation program, is now available in the Red Lake Area. This program will provide free in-home pickup of refrigerators, freezers and room air conditioners for residential customers of participating local electrical utilities across Ontario including Hydro One.

The primary rationale for this program is to eliminate unnecessary electricity consumption from older, secondary appliances. Eligible appliances are refrigerators, freezers and room air conditioners that are in operating condition, are a minimum of 10 years old, and are within specific size restrictions.

CMHC ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS FOR 2007-2008 RENOVATION PROGRAMS

Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation (CMHC) is launching a Request for Applications campaign in Ontario for the 2007-2008 renovation programs, including the Residential Rehabilitation Assistance Program (RRAP). Applications will be accepted on an ongoing basis while funding is available.

Rental and Rooming House RRAP Conversion and Secondary Garden Suite, for low-income tenants are components of the renovation programs that are the focus of the Request for Applications campaign. Another component of this campaign is the Shelter Enhancement Program (SEP) which provides funding to sponsors of shelters for victims of family violence.
