2007 PARADE ROUTE MAP

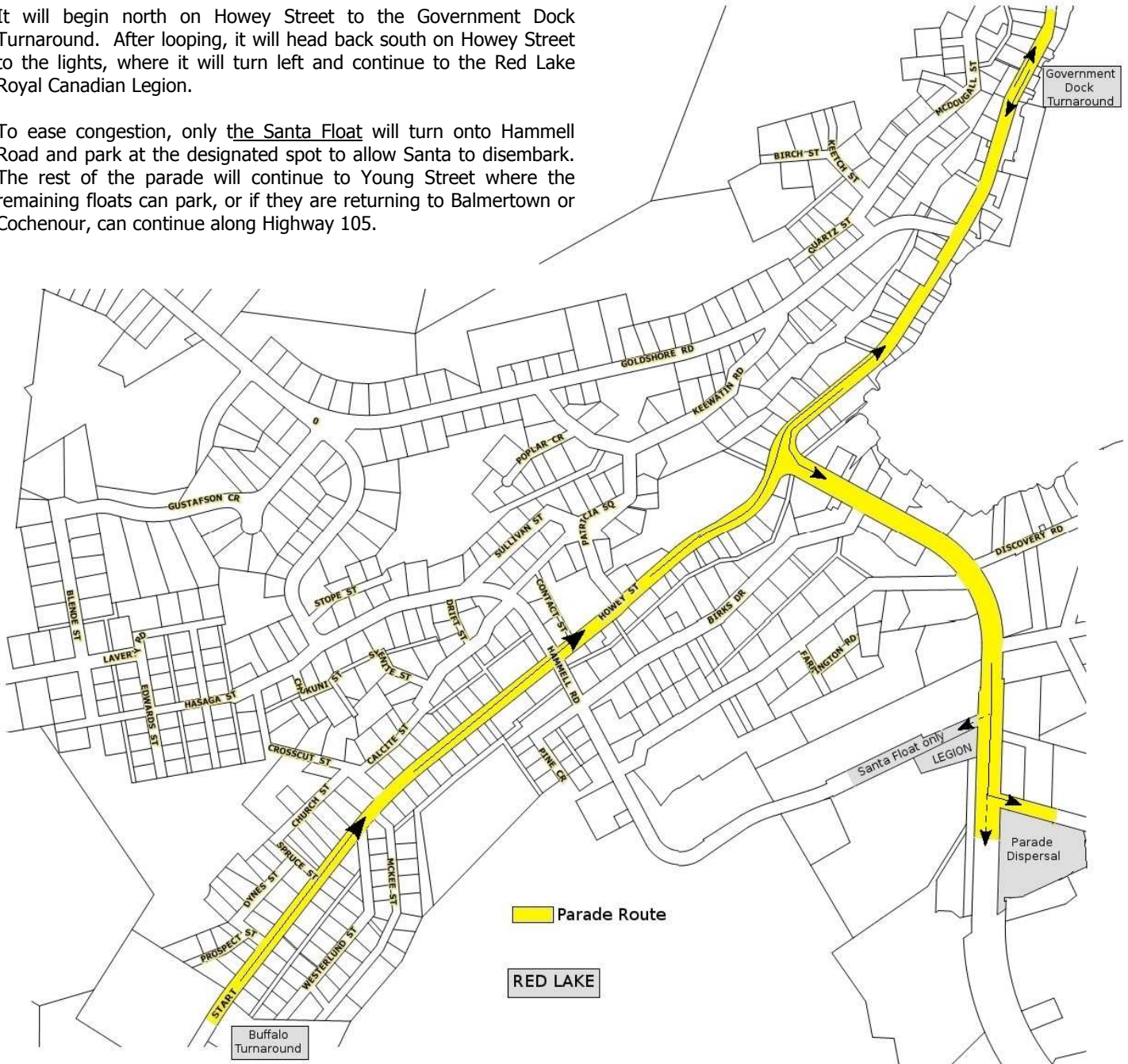
Friday, December 7th, 2007

Beginning 6:30 p.m.

We have asked floats to assemble at the Buffalo Turnaround between 6:00 p.m. and 6:20 p.m. for the parade to commence at 6:30 p.m.

It will begin north on Howey Street to the Government Dock Turnaround. After looping, it will head back south on Howey Street to the lights, where it will turn left and continue to the Red Lake Royal Canadian Legion.

To ease congestion, only the Santa Float will turn onto Hammell Road and park at the designated spot to allow Santa to disembark. The rest of the parade will continue to Young Street where the remaining floats can park, or if they are returning to Balmertown or Cochenour, can continue along Highway 105.
