NEW COLUMBARIUM - WOODLAND CEMETERY

The Municipality of Red Lake has completed the installation of a Columbarium at the Woodland Cemetery located in Balmertown. A columbarium is an aboveground structure designed for the purpose of interring cremated human remains in a niche. The niche is a hollow space in the columbarium to place cremated remains.

As per *Section 27 (1) of the Cemeteries Act, Revised, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter C.4, as amended*, a price list of all interment rights and cemetery services has been forwarded to the Registrar. The Municipality is awaiting the approval of the price list from the Registrar (Ministry of Government Services, Cemeteries Regulations).

Once the price list has been approved by the Registrar, niches will be available for sale.

A plan indicating the location and fees for the columbarium is available for inspection at the Municipal Office. Any enquiries may be made to Gail Schugmann at 735-2096, Ext. 224.
