NOTICE OF PASSING OF BY-LAW 1025-08

RE: BY-LAW NUMBER 1025-08 TO ADOPT THE ESTIMATES OF MUNICIPAL SUMS REQUIRED DURING THE YEAR AND TO STRIKE THE RATES OF TAXATION FOR THE YEAR 2008.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake has passed By-Law Number 1025-08 at the Regular Meeting of Council held Monday, May 5th, 2008, to adopt the estimates of municipal sums required and strike the rates of taxation.

A copy of the By-Law is available for inspection in the Municipal Office between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Monday to Friday.

TAKE NOTICE that the Municipality of Red Lake is bringing Plan M304 BLK B (back lane behind Brewis Avenue and Fourth Street) into compliance with the Yard Maintenance By-Law (No. 902-07). This is Municipal land and shall not be used at any time for storage of private property (boats, ice huts, campers, trailers, etc.).

FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that any private property still remaining on the land after **May 31st, 2008**, will become the property of the Municipality of Red Lake and may be sold, disposed of or destroyed.

RED LAKE AIRPORT – INCREASE - LANDING FEES

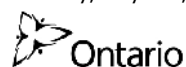

SPRING CLEAN UP

To dispose of waste from Spring Clean-Up, residents will have free access to the Red Lake and McKenzie Island Landfills from May 10th – May 17th, 2008, between the hours of 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Glass bottles will also be collected at this time. Waste taken to the Red Lake Landfill will be weighed for tracking purposes.

This is limited to domestic waste from residents and is not intended for construction and demolition waste. Appliances, tires and batteries will not be accepted. Waste from businesses will also not be accepted.

Those who require assistance removing waste to the landfill can call the Municipal Office at 735-2096, ext. 221. The Operations Department will pick up the waste for these people.

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING TO RECEIVE
INPUT ON A
ZONING BY-LAW AMENDMENT**

The Municipality of Red Lake Planning Advisory Committee will be considering an amendment to the Zoning By-Law at a public meeting on **MONDAY, 9th of JUNE, 2008 AT 5:45 p.m.** in the **COUNCIL CHAMBERS, MUNICIPAL OFFICE, BALMERTOWN.** The proposed amendment as indicated below is now available for inspection in the Planning Department office.

Written comments may be filed at the meeting or mailed to the Planning Administrator, and will be maintained for the purpose of creating a record available to the general public. If you wish to be notified of a Zoning By-Law Amendment, you must make a written request to the Planning Administrator at the address below.

Appeal of a decision of the Municipality in respect of this amendment to the zoning by-law may be made by any person or public body not later than 20 days after notice of the decision is given. If you wish to be notified of the decision of the Municipality in respect of this matter, you must make a written request to the Municipality. If a person or public body that files a notice of appeal of a decision of the Municipality of Red Lake in respect of the proposed Zoning By-Law Amendment does not make an oral submission at a public meeting or make a written submission to the Municipality of Red Lake before the proposed Zoning By-Law Amendment is adopted, the Ontario Municipal Board may dismiss all or part of the appeal.

The Zoning By-Law Amendment:

Location: Part of Mining Claims K1595, K1581 and K1582, Pickerel Drive off Highway 125, Municipality of Red Lake. This property is located in the vicinity of the Chukuni River Bridge on Highway 125.

The purpose of the amendment is to change the zoning from Rural Residential (R4) to Rural Residential (R4) with a site specific condition to allow for the keeping of a maximum of four (4) horses for personal use and to permit a home industry for servicing vehicles and selling automotive parts.
