Re: By-Law No. 1039-08, Being a By-Law to Regulate the Speed of Motor Vehicles and Erection of Municipal Street Signs

NOTICE is hereby given that the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake has passed the above-noted By-Law at the Regular Meeting of Council held Wednesday, June 4th, 2008.

Section 4 of the By-Law Provides for Rates of Speed

No person shall drive a motor vehicle at a greater rate of speed than **forty (40) kilometers** per hour on any highway under the jurisdiction of the Municipality of Red Lake



REJUVENATION IN NORSEMAN PARK

The Communities in Bloom Committee is about to embark on their summer projects, one of which is the rejuvenation of Norseman Park and other municipal areas.

A landscape expert who was invited to visit the area last year has recommended drastic pruning and soil amendment. The drastic pruning entails the removal of all old wood and is necessary to foster new growth.

The plans for this project have been reviewed and approved by Council. Actual work in Norseman Park and other selected areas will begin in mid-May and will continue throughout the summer.
