NOTICE TO ALL TAXPAYERS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF RED LAKE

If you own property in the Municipality of Red Lake please note that the 2008 Final Bills were mailed during the week of August 5th, 2008. The due dates for property taxes covering all classes are:

The first instalment was due August 29th, 2008.
The second instalment is due October 31st, 2008.

If you have not received your tax bill, please contact the Municipal Office as soon as possible. A penalty charge of 1.25% is added for non-payment the day after the due date, and the first day of each month thereafter until paid.

Payments may be made by mail, at the CIBC, Lakewood Credit Union or the Bank of Nova Scotia, or by way of Telebanking or Internet banking. They may also be paid at the Municipal Office by way of cash, credit card, debit card or cheque.

FIRE PERMITS

Please be advised that fire permits are required until October 31st, 2008. Permits cost \$5.00 and may be picked up at the Municipal Office, 2 Fifth Street, Balmertown during regular business hours, 8:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. Monday to Friday.

RESTRICTED DISPOSAL PERIOD

As of April 1st, 2008, the Municipality of Red Lake has declared a 'Restricted Disposal Period'.

Residents are required to **deposit waste in containers on the day of collection and no earlier.** Residents who do not comply with this restriction may be charged a fine as per the Waste Disposal By-Law.
