NOTICE TO ALL CONSUMERS OF MUNICIPAL WATER AND SEWER SERVICES

By-Law No. 949-07 was adopted by Council on December 4, 2008. This by-law governs and regulates the operation of every water and sewage system owned or operated by the Municipality. The by-law provides many rules and regulations for the use, operation and maintenance of the water and sewage system owned or operated by the Municipality.

PLEASE BE ADVISED that any consumer (applicant for water/sewer service and includes the owner or occupant of the premises served) who open or close any valve, hydrant or gate in the street mains, or interfere with the same in any manner, **except a certified operator approved by the Municipality** may be charged a fine as per the By-Law.

IMPORTANT. If a consumer hires a contractor, who may be a certified operator, the contractor must still be approved by the Municipality prior to opening or closing any valves and the consumer will be charged the fine. The set fines for any infractions under By-Law No. 949-07 is \$400.00.
