NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

APPLICATION FOR MINOR VARIANCE TO THE ZONING BY-LAW

Planning Act, R.S.O.1990 C.p.13, S.45(1)

The Municipality of Red Lake Committee of Adjustment will be considering an application for Minor Variance at a public meeting as follows:

Date, Time and Location of Public Meeting: March 9th, 2009, 5:45 p.m., Council Chambers in the Municipal Office, Townsite of Balmertown

Purpose: to reduce Industrial Zoning setback regulations as identified in the Zoning By-Law. This application is to reduce the front yard 4.3 metres, which is a relief of 10.7 metres. Secondly this application is to reduce setback regulations for the side yards to 1 metre, and narrowing to 0.5 metres within the opposite side yard, which is a relief of 3.5 metres and 4 metres respectively.

Effect: to allow for the construction of an airport hanger building measuring 27 x 24 metres. The use of the building will be to provide aircraft storage and allow for maintenance services.

Location and description of subject land: This property is owned by the Municipality of Red Lake and leased at the Red Lake Airport. It is described as Part 3 on Reference Plan 23R-6812. The street address is 2508 Highway 125, Town site of Cochenour, Municipality of Red Lake. The total area of the land upon which this Minor Variance is being requested, is 0.125 Hectares. Present use of the land is for storage within a preexisting small building and outdoor aircraft storage.

Other Planning Act Applications: at this time the subject land is not the subject of any other applications under the Planning Act.

Additional information from the complete applications for proposed minor variances is now available for inspection at the Municipal Office.

Public Hearing: You are entitled to attend this public hearing in person to express your views about this application or you may submit written comments to be read by the Committee at the hearing. If you wish to make written comments on this application they may be forwarded to the Secretary-Treasurer of the Committee at the address below. If you are aware of any person interested in or affected by this application who has not received a copy of this notice you are requested to inform that person of this hearing.

Failure to attend hearing: If you do not attend the hearing it may proceed in your absence and, except as otherwise provided in the *Planning Act*, you will not be entitled to any further notice in the proceedings.

Notice of Decision: A copy of the decision of the Committee will be sent to the applicant and to each person who appeared in person or by Council at the hearing and who has filed with the Secretary-Treasurer a written request to receive the notice of decision.
