The Miss McKenzie 11 is out of service due to a mechanical breakdown.

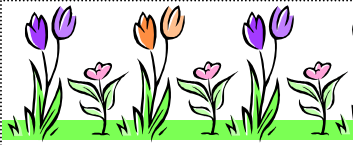
A date for the Ferry's return to service has yet to be determined. Updates will be announced as information is received.

NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING**APPLICATION FOR MINOR VARIANCE TO THE ZONING BY-LAW**

Planning Act, R.S.O.1990 C.p.13, S.45(1)

The Municipality of Red Lake Committee of Adjustment will be considering an application for Minor Variance at a Public Meeting as follows:

Date, Time and location of Public Meeting: June 8th, 2009, 5:45 p.m., Council Chambers in the Municipal Office, Townsite of Balmertown

Location and description of subject land: This property is located at 113 Buffalo Street, described as Lot 2 on Plan M-355, Townsite of Red Lake. The adjacent lot to that of the proposed setback is presently vacant.

Purpose: to reduce Townsite Residential (R1) setback regulations as identified in the Zoning By-Law for this proposal. This application is to reduce the setback regulations for a side yard. The southeast side yard would be 0.3 metres, which is a relief of 0.69 metres.

Effect: to allow for the construction of a 6 x 9 metre garage on the southeast side of the property, beside an existing residence.

Other Planning Act Applications: at this time the subject land is not the subject of any other applications under the Planning Act.

Additional information from the complete application for proposed minor variance is now available for inspection at the Municipal Office.

Public Hearing: You are entitled to attend this public hearing in person to express your views about this application, or you may submit written comments to be read by the Committee at the hearing. If you wish to make written comments on this application they may be forwarded to the secretary-treasurer of the Committee at the address below. If you are aware of any person interested in or affected by this application who has not received a copy of this notice you are requested to inform that person of this hearing.

Failure to attend hearing: If you do not attend the hearing it may proceed in your absence and, except as otherwise provided in the *Planning Act*, you will not be entitled to any further notice in the proceedings.

Notice of Decision: A copy of the decision of the Committee will be sent to the applicant and to each person who appeared in person or by council at the hearing and who has filed with the secretary-treasurer a written request to receive the notice of decision.
