NOTICE OF AN OPEN HOUSE AND PUBLIC MEETING

Zoning By-Law Update

Take Notice That the Municipality has begun the undertaking to revise the Zoning By-Law in accordance with Section 34 of the *Planning Act*. The Municipality will hold an Open House and a Public Meeting to consider and discuss changes that will be made.

An Open House will be held on Tuesday, June 23rd, 2009, between 4:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. at the **Red Lake Community Centre, 10 Hammell Road, Red Lake.** (see above)

The Public Meeting will be held on Thursday, June 25th, 2009, at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Office located at 2 Fifth Street, Balmertown.

Purpose and Effect: The Municipality's current Zoning By-Law requires revision in order to address general changes and to be in conformity with Red Lake's 2006 Official Plan. The Municipality is required to hold an Open House for the purpose of giving the public an opportunity to review and ask questions about the information and materials made available regarding the zoning by-law update. The purpose of the Public Meeting is to present the proposed changes to the public and provide the public with an opportunity to make representations in respect of the proposed new by-law. The planning consultant will be in attendance at both events to provide information to the public on the proposed zoning by-law. Proposed changes include updating definitions, new map schedules, and improved general provisions for setbacks, separation distances and parking standards.

Any Person may attend the open house and the public meeting. Additional information and material related to the Zoning By-Law update is available for public inspection during regular office hours at the Municipal Office located at 2 Fifth Street in Balmertown. A date for passing the new Zoning By-Law has not yet been established. The Zoning By-Law applies to all lands within the municipal boundaries of the Municipality of Red Lake. The public meeting to be held on June 25th, 2009, is not required under the *Planning Act*. The public meeting required to be held under Section 12(a)(ii) of the *Planning Act* will be held at a later date and will be duly advertised in accordance with the Act.

Take Notice that if a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Municipality of Red Lake before the by-law is passed, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the Council of the Municipality of Red Lake to the Ontario Municipal Board. If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting, or make written submissions to the Municipality of Red Lake before the by-law is passed, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Municipal Board unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds to do so.
