SPECIES AT RISK PROJECT WITH THE ONTARIO MINISTRY OF NATURAL RESOURCES



In May of this year, the Municipality of Red Lake received approval for funding from the Provincial Government's Species at Risk Stewardship Program. In partnership with the Ministry of Natural Resources, the Municipality will be conducting several surveys aimed at increasing our knowledge of species at risk and their habitats that occur within the Municipality. Through the development of a brochure and staff participation at local events, efforts will also focus on public awareness and overall understanding of Species at Risk within our community. Some known examples of species at risk in our area include Bald Eagle (*Special Concern*), Woodland Caribou (*Threatened*), Wolverine (*Threatened*) and Lake Sturgeon (*Special Concern*).

The Species at Risk (SAR) Stewardship Fund's main objective is to provide communities and groups with the opportunity to survey, inventory and monitor species at risk and their habitat and in turn create plans for protection and recovery. This information can also be used in order to create awareness and local educational opportunities for youth and adults alike. The Municipality of Red Lake looks forward to working with the Ministry of Natural Resources on this project, which is the first of its kind in the region. 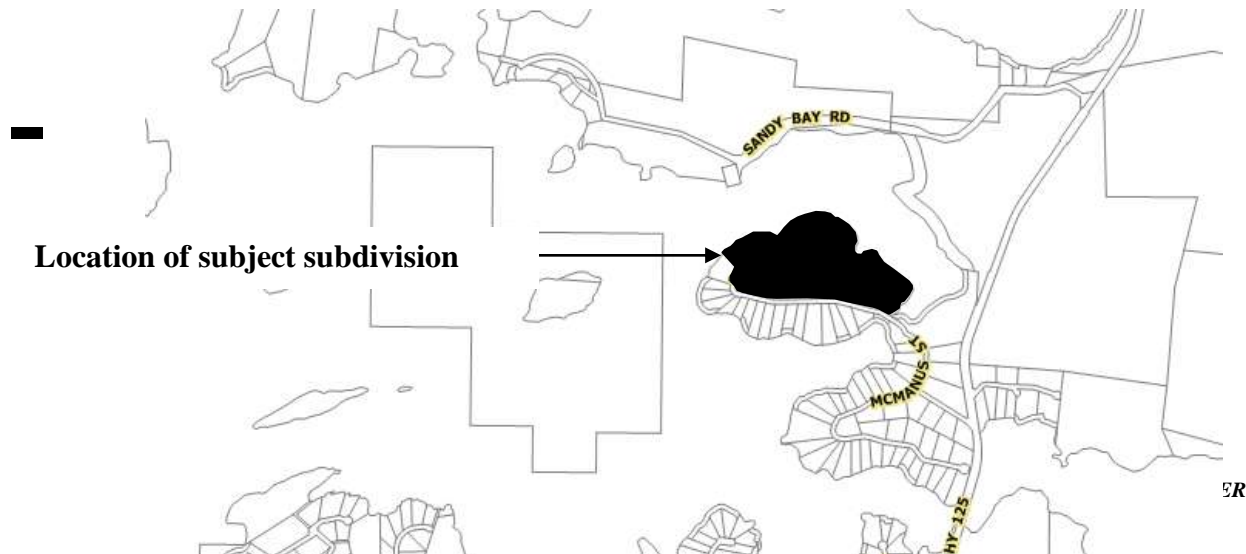

PROPERTY DESCRIPTION: The subject property is described as Mining Claims K1582, KRL1583, KRL1584, K1597, KRL 854, KRL 21755; CL 14787; Block 22 of Plan M-787; and, Parts 1 and 2 of Plan 23R-11572; Parcel 6114; Township of Dome, Patricia Portion. The designation of the area under the Red Lake Official Plan is Rural Residential (RR); and within the Zoning By-Law the area is described as Rural Residential (R4).

LOCATION OF PROPERTY: This property is accessed by McManus Street in the rural residential area known as the Chukuni subdivision, adjacent Provincial Highway 125, Municipality of Red Lake.

FAILURE TO MAKE WRITTEN SUBMISSION: If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at the Public Meeting or make written submissions to the Planning Advisory Committee in respect of the proposed plan of subdivision before the approval authority gives or refuses to give approval to the draft plan of subdivision;

- i) the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake to the Ontario Municipal Board;
- ii) the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Municipal Board unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds to do so.
