PORTABLE STORAGE SHEDS AND GARAGES

Please be aware that under the Zoning By-Law No. 817-07, portable storage sheds and garages are required to comply with the same regulations as permanent structures and buildings.

For example, accessory buildings and structures in the Townsite Residential (R1) Zone are regulated by setback requirements including:

"...shall not be built closer to the front lot line or exterior side lot line than the minimum distance required by this By-Law for the main building" (Minimum Front Yard - 6.0 meters and Minimum Side Yard -1 meter); and,

"...shall not be built closer to the street than the main building is to the street..."
