ACCESSIBILITY POLICY

The Municipality of Red Lake is considering adopting an Accessible Customer Service Policy at the next Regular Meeting of Council to be held on November 3rd, 2009. The Policy is drafted in accordance with the Accessibility Standards for Customer Service (Regulation 429/07). The Policy addresses the following:

- The provision of goods and services to persons with disabilities;
- The use of assistive devices by persons with disabilities;
- The use of service animals by person with disabilities;
- The use of support persons by persons with disabilities;
- Notice of temporary disruptions in services and facilities;
- Training;
- Customer feedback regarding the provision of goods and services to persons with disabilities; and
- Notice of availability and format of documents.

ACCESSIBILITY PLAN

The Municipality is reviewing and updating their Accessibility Plan for the 2010 year. The Plan describes the measures the Municipality has taken in the past and the measures the Municipality will take during the current year to identify, remove and prevent barriers to people with disabilities who use the facilities and services of the Municipality. Agendas can be picked up at the Municipal Office after 3:00 p.m. on the Friday before the Meeting.

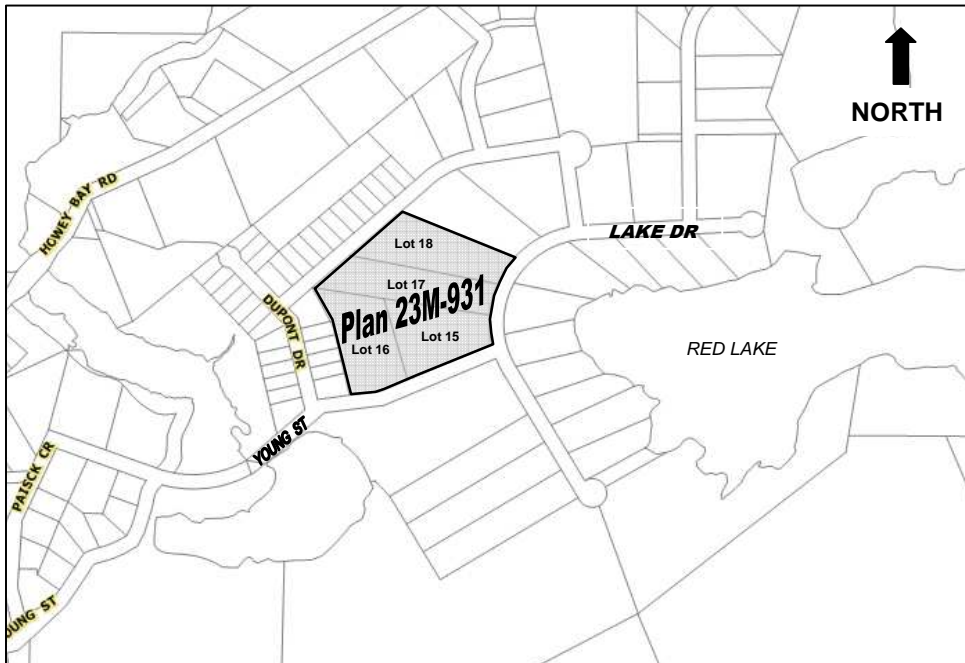
NOTICE OF PASSING OF BY-LAW NO. 1243-09**ZONING BY-LAW AMENDMENT PLANNING FILE NO. D14-09-06***The Planning Act s.34 (18)*

NOTICE is hereby given that the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake passed By-Law No. 1243-09 at their Regular Meeting held Tuesday, October 20th, 2009, to adopt a Zoning By-Law Amendment. Notice of the Application was given in reference to Planning File No. D14-09-06.

PURPOSE: The purpose of this Amendment is to rezone the subject lands from the Rural Residential Zone (R4) to the Townsite Residential Zone (R1).

EFFECT: This Amendment will have the effect of allowing for the use of lands to change from the Rural Residential Zone (R4) uses and regulations to the Townsite Residential Zone (R1) uses and regulations.

LOCATION OF SUBJECT LAND: Lots 15, 16, 17 and 18 on Plan 23M-931; in the vicinity of the Kelson Farm town site, Municipality of Red Lake.



THE LAST DATE FOR FILING A NOTICE OF APPEAL is November 17th, 2009.

Notices of appeal:

- i. must be filed with the Clerk of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake,
- ii. must set out the reasons for the appeal, and
- iii. must be accompanied by the fee required by the Municipal Board of \$125.00

Only individuals, corporations and public bodies may appeal a by-law to the Ontario Municipal Board. A notice of appeal may not be filed by an unincorporated association or group. However, a notice of appeal may be filed in the name of an individual who is a member of the association or the group on its behalf.

No person or public body shall be added as a party to the hearing of appeal unless, before the by-law is passed, the person or public body made oral submissions at a public meeting or written submissions to the council or, in the opinion of the Ontario Municipal Board, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or public body as a party.

OTHER PLANNING APPLICATIONS RELEVANT TO THE SUBJECT LOCATION: The subject location is also the subject of an application for approval of a plan of subdivision, to this date, under Planning File No. D12-09-02.

A copy of the By-Law is available for inspection in the Municipal Office between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Monday to Friday.
