MUNICIPAL WASTE MANAGEMENT INITIATIVES

- A Long Term Waste Management Strategy has been completed. This report provides the Municipality with a long term strategy in waste management.
- A Draft Waste Management By-Law has been prepared which will regulate the management and collection of waste and recyclable material in Red Lake.
- The Balmertown Waste Disposal Site Construction will be commencing this summer. This also includes the application for the 100,000 cu. m. expansion at the Waste Disposal Site.

The Cochenour Playground will be closed to the Public for the duration of the reconstruction of the grounds. We apologize for the inconvenience and thank you for your patience.

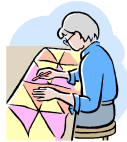
