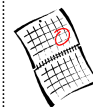

For a Municipal Cultural Plan for Red Lake

The Municipality of Red Lake will soon be undertaking a Municipal Cultural Plan (MCP). The MCP will include community consultations and research that will help the Municipality identify the area's cultural resources and integrate them with economic and tourism development initiatives, youth activities, school and public programs and environmental projects. The project will be coordinated by the Red Lake Regional Heritage Centre.

The Project Lead is required to perform the following work:

- 1) Update, upgrade and expand the publication *"Uncovering our Heritage: An Inventory of available Heritage Resources in the Red Lake Region"* (published in 1995).
- 2) Establish a committee to develop the Municipal Cultural Plan and implement it
- 3) Develop a communications/marketing strategy.

Applicants must have strong research and communications skills and previous experience in researching, initiating and coordinating cultural projects.
