Municipal Recycling Program

Due to the numerous comments received through the Draft Waste Management By-Law Public Meeting process, the Municipality of Red Lake will not be implementing the curbside recycling program on August 1, 2010. A Special Meeting of Council will be held on Thursday, July 29, 2010, at 10:00 a.m., in the Municipal Council Chambers to further discuss the comments and the Draft Waste Management By-Law.

Starting Wednesday, August 4, 2010, all residents may dispose of their recycling products at the Recycling Transfer Station at the Waste Disposal Site and in turn these products will be transferred to the recycling facility in Winnipeg. There will be no charge for this service.

Below is a list of recycling products that will be accepted at the Waste Disposal Site and examples of products that are not recyclable. The Municipality is not set up to accept glass at this time.



Recyclable

- All steel or tin cans
- All aluminum beverage containers with Recycle Symbol #1 - #7
- Waxed milk and juice cartons
- Tetrapacks (juice boxes)
- Newspaper, white paper, brown paper, wrapping paper
- Corrugated cardboard, broken down
- Box board (single layer, non-corrugated)
- Books (remove hard covers)
- Cardboard egg cartons, mailing tubes
- Magazines, catalogues

Not Recyclable

- Glass
- Aerosol cans, propane bottles
- Plastic with no recycle symbol
- Plastic bags, plastic packaging
- Toys, flower pots
- Styrofoam
- Aluminum foil, pie plates, etc.
- Scrap metal (hangers)
- Anything containing a hazardous substance (motor oil, paint thinner, paint, etc.)
