**ACCESSORY BUILDING AND TEMPORARY SHELTERS**

**Municipality of Red Lake ZONING BY- LAW**  
Adopted by By-Law No. 1277-10 on February 16<sup>th</sup>, 2010

Dear Home Owner;

The following are the current By-Laws with respect to **Temporary Shelters**

- **Temporary shelters** are considered Accessory buildings.
- Each home owner is allowed only **1 Temporary shelter** per lot.
- Each Temporary shelter is **not to exceed 25 sq.M.** (approx. 12ft. X 22ft.)
- Temporary shelters are **not to be erected closer to the front lot line than the main building.**
- **And** if on a corner lot, **not closer to the exterior side lot line than the main building.**
- If your lot **abuts a lane**, Temporary shelters **must have a 2M set back from the lot line on the lane side.**
- If the Temporary shelter is **at the rear of your lot then 1M set back** from the rear lot line and **if on an interior lot 1M set back from the side lot line.**
- The Temporary shelter **must also be 1.5M away from any other building.**

This will help you determine if you are in compliance with the Zoning By-Law and if not how much you have to move the Temporary shelter in order to comply.
