* All garbage bags placed on the curb for pick-up are required to have a \$2.00 bag tag. Locations where tags will be available for sale will be advertised in the Municipal Newsletter and The Northern Sun newspaper at a later date.

** **Glass shall be recycled but must be placed in a separate container for collection.** Regular residential recyclables will not be picked up if glass is mixed in.

RE-USEABLE ITEMS may be recycled by dropping them off at the Transfer Station located at the Waste Disposal Site. Re-usable items will not be collected by the garbage collector.

The following items are not included in curbside recycling: Plastic with no recycle symbol, plastic bags, plastic packaging, toys, flower pots, Styrofoam, aluminum foil, pie plates, etc.

The following recyclable items can be included in curb side recycling pick-up.

All steel or tin cans
All aluminum beverage cans
All plastic containers with Recycle Symbol #1 - #7
Waxed milk and juice cartons

Tetrapacks (juice boxes)
Newspaper, white paper, brown paper, wrapping paper
Corrugated cardboard, broken down
Box board (single layer, non-corrugated)
Books (remove hard cover)

The following recyclable items will not be picked up but can be taken to the Waste Disposal Site at no cost.

Tires
Clean Wood (non-painted, non-stained or non-treated)
Brush
* Household Hazardous Waste

E-Waste
Scrap Metal
Aluminum

* ***Hazardous Household Waste items (motor oil, paint, propane bottles, aerosol cans etc.) will be accepted at the Waste Disposal Site on Saturdays, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.***
