Hours Extended

In order to accommodate electors, the Ballot Return/Revision Centre (located at the Municipal Office) has extended their hours of operation. In addition to the dates and times noted on the side of this Newsletter, the additional hours are:

Monday, October 18th, 2010
9:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.

Tuesday, October 19th, 2010
9:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.

If you did not receive a Vote by Mail Voter's Kit, please attend the Ballot Return/Revision Centre at the Municipal Office to amend the Voters' List and sign a declaration form to receive a Blank Voter's Kit.

Traditional Advance Polls

For purposes of using the Vote-by-Mail system, Advance Polls are not necessary but will be deemed to be conducted during the following time frame while the Ballot Return/Revision Centre (located at the Municipal Office) is open:

October 4th – 22nd, 2010
Monday - Friday
(9:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.)

October 25th, 2010
(10:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.)

Also during this period, Return Voter's Kits may be received by mail; returned by hand; and/or persons not on the Voter's List may obtain a Replacement /Blank Voter's Kit.

A Vote by Mail Voter's Kit includes:

- 1. The Voting Instructions and Declaration Form (all on one form)**
- 2. One Ballot**
- 3. White Ballot Secrecy Envelope**
- 4. Yellow Election Return Envelope**

Tips for Completing your Ballot

- 1. Sign the Declaration Form** and detach from the voting instructions.
- 2. Place the signed Declaration Form in the yellow Election Return Envelope** (do not seal the yellow envelope).
- 3. Complete the Ballot** by voting for the candidate(s) of your choice. Use a blue or black ink pen and completely fill in the oval next to your choice(s).
- 4. Place the completed Ballot into the white Ballot Secrecy Envelope and seal the white Ballot Secrecy Envelope.**
- 5. Insert the sealed white Ballot Secrecy Envelope into the yellow Election Return Envelope** (the signed Declaration Form should already be inside the yellow return envelope).
- 6. Seal the yellow Election Return Envelope.** The yellow Election Return Envelope is your **"Return Voter's Kit"**.
- 7. Mail at the Post Office or hand deliver at the Municipal Office the sealed yellow Election Return Envelope (Return Voter's Kit).**

After October 16, 2010, electors are encouraged to hand deliver completed Return Voter's Kit at the Municipal Office to ensure it will be received in time for the close of polls at 8:00 p.m. on October 25, 2010.
