\$132,070.63 RAISED BY CANADIAN CANCER SOCIETY, RED LAKE BRANCH IN 2010

On Wednesday, February 23rd, Mayor Phil Vinet was presented with a plaque from the Canadian Cancer Society Northwest, honouring the Municipality of Red Lake, its citizens and Canadian Cancer Society Volunteers for their enthusiasm and commitment to the Society.

The hard work of the Relay for Life Committee, the many volunteers and the generosity of the community in supporting such fundraising events as the Muskoka Chair Auction, Dragon Boat Races, Quilt for a Cure, Daffodil Days and the Relay for Life resulted in \$132,070.63 being raised in 2010. This was the highest amount per capita in the Province of Ontario for 2010.
