DISTRACTED DRIVING

Distracted Driving is cited as a casual factor in 30 to 50 percent of traffic collisions in Ontario, but is probably much higher due to under-reporting. Distracted Driving Kills? Using a cell phone or device capable of texting while driving can result in a fine of \$155 under Section 78.1 of the Highway Traffic Act (HTA). Watching an entertainment device can result in a fine of \$110 under the HTA.

Other forms of Distracted Driving can result in a charge of Careless Driving with fines ranging from \$400 to \$2,000, a possible license suspension of up to two years and/or a jail term of not more than six months.
