A total of 213 bags of garbage were collected on Saturday, May 7th, by volunteers from McKenzie Island, Cochenour, Balmertown, Red Lake, and Madsen, with help from the organizing group, Communities in Bloom, and from the Municipality. Participation was good this year in all communities. Mayor Phil Vinet joined in the efforts.

The final results were tallied as follows: The Red Lake (99) /Madsen (32) participants won the challenge with total of (131) bags of garbage, while Balmertown (42)/ Cochenour (40)/ McKenzie Island (20) registered a total of (102). The 8th Annual Garb-a-thon has been won by Red Lake/Madsen: 131 to 82 over BT/CO/MI. (about 20% of the bags were recyclables).
