**DOG BY-LAW**



No person shall suffer, allow or permit any dog, of which he/she is the owner to run at large within the limits of the Municipality of Red Lake.

A dog shall be deemed to be running at large when found in any place other than the premises of the owner of the dog and not under the direct control of a competent person.

A dog shall be deemed not to be under the control of a competent person when the dog is not on a leash held by the competent person.

No owner shall suffer, allow or permit his/her dog to defecate on private or public property without immediate removal.

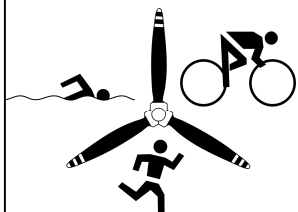
