Is Your Home Likely To Attract a Burglar?

Answer these 10 simple questions to find out whether your home is vulnerable.

1. Are there clear views of all windows and doors of your home and garage (ie. Not obscured by bushes or high fences)?
2. Do you lock your doors at night, or while you are away? This includes your garage and your vehicle doors.
3. Do you store your house and vehicle keys in a location that is out of sight, within your home?
4. Do your exterior doors have a deadbolt lock?
5. Do all of the windows have secure locks on them?
6. Do you store your valuables in a safety deposit box or in a secure part of your home?
7. Have you recorded the serial numbers of your expensive items, and keep this list in a secure location? (ie. Television, laptop, camera, bicycle, etc)
8. Do you leave lights on timers or motion-activated while you are sleeping, or away?
9. Do you know your neighbours across the street and on all sides of you?
10. Have you been burglarized in the past, and do thieves know that your property is easy to steal?



Results: Add up the number of "yes" answers you had.

7-10 You are in good shape but you may want to improve on areas where you answered "no".

4-6 Your home would benefit from security improvements.

1-5 Your home is vulnerable- take action!
