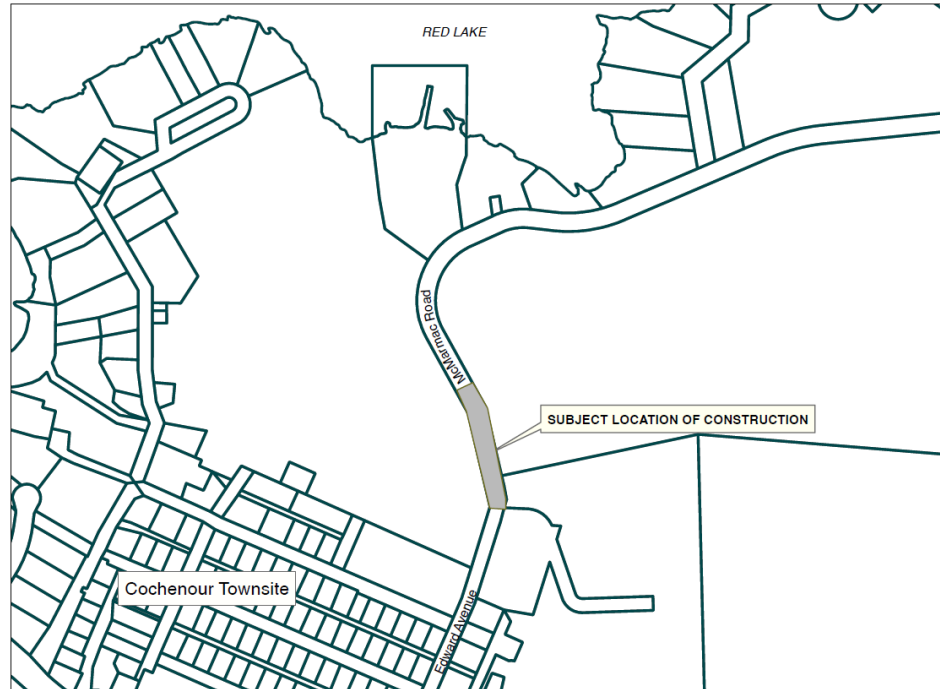
Committee of the Whole and Regular Council meetings are open to the Public. The Meetings will commence at the times noted above.
