- iii) For each additional dog owned in excess of two is \$100.00.

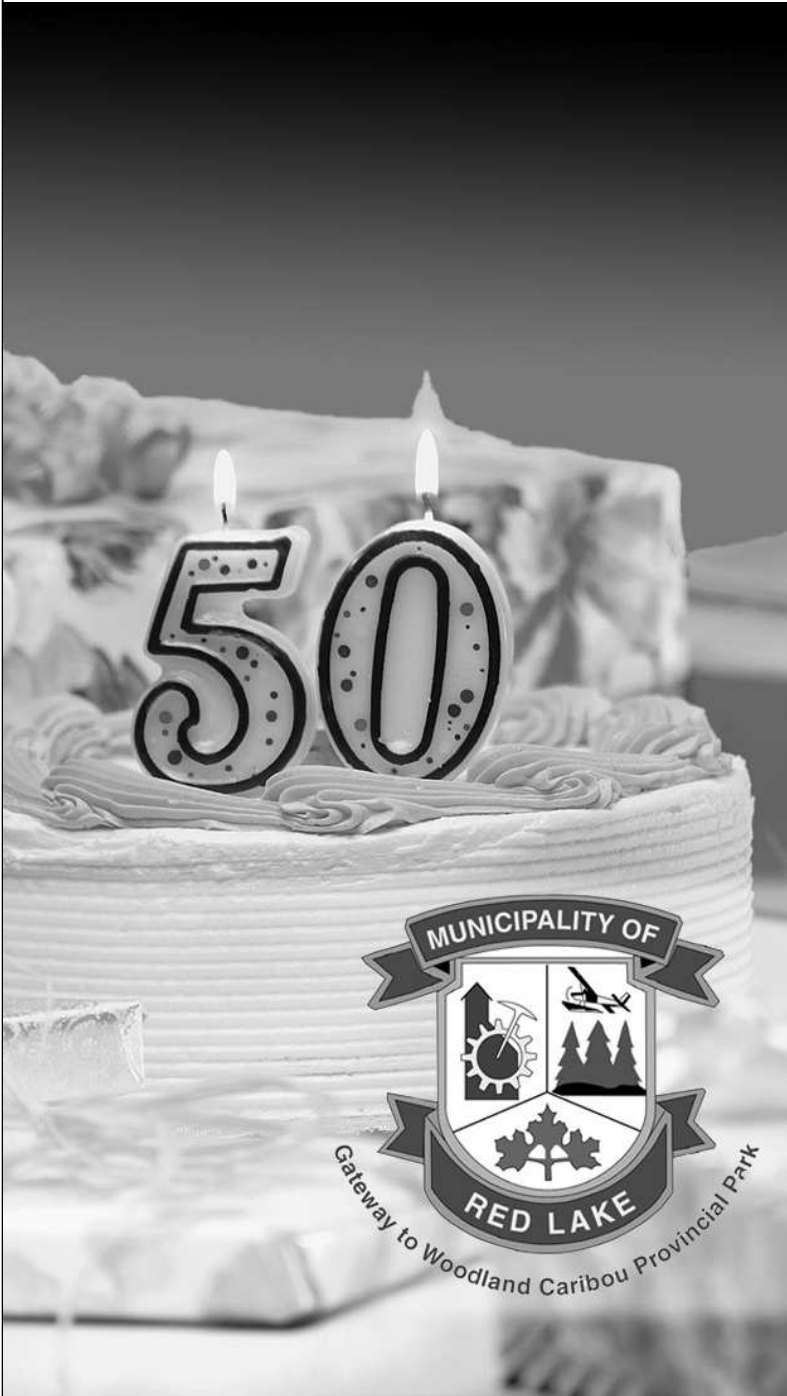
After January 31st, 2012, there will be a late penalty of \$5.00 per license.
