**NOTICE**

**MOTORIZED SNOW VEHICLE ROUTES**

The Municipality of Red Lake has been receiving complaints regarding snowmobiles traveling in an unsafe manner along Detta Road in Balmertown. Snowmobiles are traveling between the snow banks and the yards instead of along the road, this may create a unsafe situation.

The following named municipal highways shall only be used as access highways for motorized snow vehicles to leave and return to the town sites:

As per By-Law No. 5-01, no person shall operate a motorized snow vehicle upon any highway and/or area under the jurisdiction of the Municipality, except for the above noted highways. **These highways are to be used as access roads to the trails only. You must use the shortest route to the access roads from your home.** While traveling these routes a motorized snow vehicle must not reach speeds greater than 20 km/hr.

## NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND PUBLIC MEETING FOR ZONING BY-LAW AMENDMENT FILE NUMBER D14-11-06

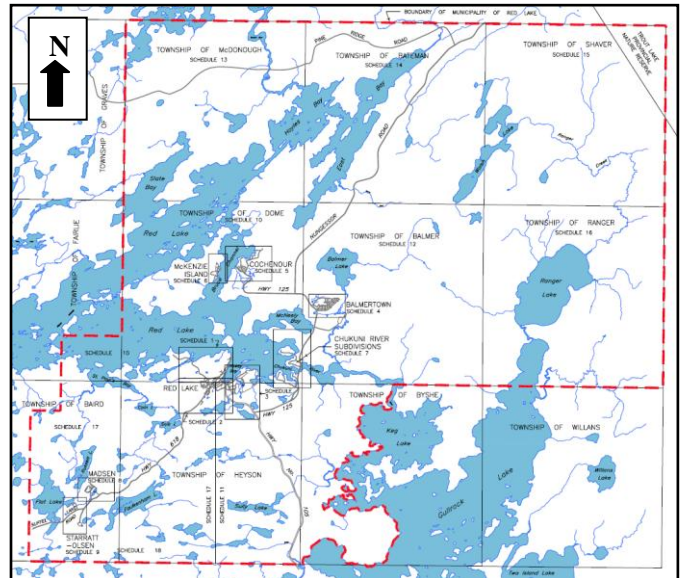
Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.13, s. 34 (13).

**TAKE NOTICE** that the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake has received a complete application for the Zoning By-Law Amendment described as follows:

**LOCATION OF PROPERTY:** All land zoned or used for commercial purposes within the Municipality. Refer to a sketch of the Municipal Boundary to the right.

**PROPERTY DESCRIPTION:** Land within the Municipality that is zoned for various commercial uses including Townsite Commercial, Local Commercial, Shopping Centre Commercial, Highway Commercial, and Tourist Commercial.

**PURPOSE AND EFFECT OF APPLICATION:** To change the definitions and general land use provisions of the Zoning By-Law to regulate outdoor patios associated with a commercial use; wording proposed as follows:



### Section 2: Definitions

**Outdoor Patio** – Shall mean a commercially operated outdoor premise, area, deck or set aside platform of the ground floor; with or without a roof, a foundation, an attachment to a building, or direct access to the ground, for use of patrons as part of a restaurant or tavern, in connection with and in addition to, the operation of the indoor use that it is contiguous to, which area is designed and intended to be used seasonally as a sundeck.

### Section 3.21.1: General Provisions

**Outdoor Patios:** Notwithstanding any other provisions of this By-Law, the following shall apply to an *outdoor patio* associated with a permitted commercial use including a *restaurant* or *tavern*.

- (a) **Capacity:** No outdoor patio shall accommodate more than fifty per cent (50%) of the licensed indoor capacity of the restaurant or tavern with which the patio is associated with.
- (b) **Location:** No outdoor patio shall be located in a yard abutting a residential or institutional zone. No part of an outdoor patio shall be located less than 10 metres (32.8 ft) from lands zoned for residential or institutional use. No outdoor patio shall be raised above the grade of the finished floor elevation of the ground floor.
- (c) **Yard Encroachment:** Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 3.31, no outdoor patio associated with a commercial use shall be permitted to encroach into a required yard.
- (d) **Lighting:** All outdoor lighting shall be directed toward or onto the patio area and away from adjoining properties and streets.
- (e) **Parking:** Parking spaces shall be required for the total gross floor area associated with the outdoor patio at a ratio of 80% as for a restaurant or tavern.

**TAKE NOTICE** that the application under the above file number will be heard by the Planning Advisory Committee (PAC) of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake on the date, and at the time and place shown below. The Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake may consider a decision regarding the application at their regular meeting following this public meeting.

**PUBLIC MEETING:** You are entitled to attend this public meeting in person to express your views about the application. If you are aware of any person interested in or affected by the application who has not received a copy of this notice you are requested to inform that person of this meeting. If you wish to make written comments on the application, they may be forwarded to the Clerk of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake, at the address below.

**FAILURE TO MAKE ORAL OR WRITTEN SUBMISSION:** If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake before the by-law is passed:

- a) the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake to the Ontario Municipal Board.
- b) the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Municipal Board unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds to do so.

Appeal of a decision of the Municipality in respect of this amendment to the Zoning By-Law may be made by any person or public body not later than 20 days after notice of the decision is given.

**NOTICE OF DECISION:** If you wish to be notified of the decision of the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake in respect of the application for Zoning By-Law Amendment, you must make a written request to the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake at the address shown below.
