NOTICE is hereby given to the Municipal Electors of the Municipality of Red Lake. Offices for which persons may be nominated:

In accordance with Section 33 (1) of the *Municipal Elections Act, R.S.O., 1996*, candidates for the above-noted offices may file nomination papers in the Clerk's Office, corner of Fifth Street and Lassie Road, Balmertown, Ontario.

Nomination papers shall be in the prescribed form; be accompanied by a declaration of qualification in the prescribed form, signed by the person being nominated and be accompanied by the prescribed nomination filing fee (payable by cash, money order or certified cheque) of \$200 for the office of Mayor or \$100 for all other offices. Faxed or photocopied forms cannot be accepted.

Nomination papers may be filed with the Clerk between the hours of 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., commencing immediately, until Thursday, September 25, 2003, or between the hours of 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. on Nomination Day, Friday, September 26, 2003. (Clerk's Office open between 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on Nomination Day.)

For the purpose of District School Board nominations, the Trustee determination has been made in accordance with the *Education Act and Regulations*. Persons proposing to be nominated for the District Board Offices listed above may request assistance from the Clerk of the Municipality of Red Lake.

If there is an insufficient number of candidates for any office, additional nominations for the remaining vacancies in the office may be filed with the Clerk on the Wednesday following Nomination Day, being October 1, 2003, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

Electors are hereby given notice that if a greater number of candidates are certified than are required to fill the said offices, voting places will be opened as follows for the purpose of voting:

- ADVANCE VOTE - Saturday, November 1st, 2003 (10:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m.)
 - Red Lake Fire Station, Red Lake

CLERK'S NOTICE OF POSTING OF THE PRELIMINARY LIST OF ELECTORS
(MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS ACT, R.S.O. 1996)

NOTICE is hereby given that I have complied with Section 23 of the *Municipal Elections Act, R.S.O., 1996*, and that I have available in my office at Balmertown, Ontario, the list of persons eligible to vote in the Municipality at Municipal Elections and the list remains there for inspection.

I hereby call upon all electors to examine the list and to take immediate proceedings to have any errors or omissions corrected according to law.

During the period September 2, 2003, to the close of voting on November 10, 2003, a person may make an application to the Clerk requesting that the person's name be added to or removed from or amended on the voter's list.

During the period September 2, 2003, and September 26, 2003, a person may make an application to the Clerk requesting that another person's name be removed from the voter's list.

Revisions to the list will be undertaken in the Municipality of Red Lake Municipal Office, Fifth Street, Balmertown, Ontario, during normal office hours Tuesday, September 2, 2003, through to Friday, November 7, 2003, after which additions may be made at the voting place.

QUALIFICATIONS OF ELECTORS

A person is entitled to be an elector at an election held in a local municipality if on Voting Day, Monday, November 10, 2003, he or she:

- (a) resides in the local municipality or is the owner or tenant of land there, or the spouse or same-sex partner of such owner or tenant;
- (b) is a Canadian Citizen;
- (c) is at least 18 years old; and
- (d) is not disqualified under this or any other Act.

Persons who are a resident in the Municipality of Red Lake and are eighteen years of age or older are eligible to apply.

Persons with previous experience are encouraged to apply.

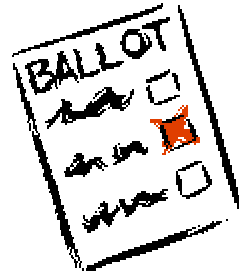
Interested persons can pick up applications forms at the address listed below during normal office hours. Applications will be accepted up to and including October 17, 2003.
