Please be advised that each time you utilize the Ferry these passes must be presented to the Captains, if you do not have the pass you will have to pay the per trip fee or you will not be allowed to ride the Ferry.

When the ambulance or police require the services of the Ferry, they will get first priority. If the boat is in the middle of the lake and emergency vehicles arrive, the boat will be turned around and will stay available to them until released.

STUDENT EMPLOYMENT

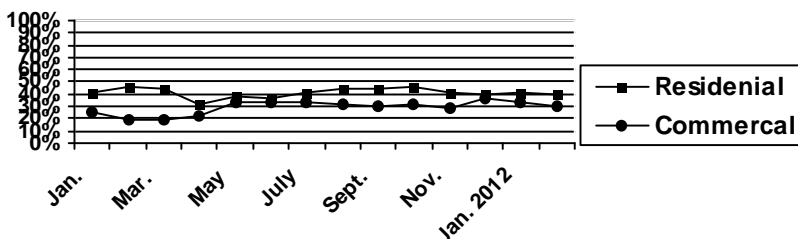
The Municipality of Red Lake is presently accepting applications for summer employment for the Child Care and Recreation Departments.

Waste Diversion Percentage

Residential waste diversion for the month of February 2012 is 39%. This is a 2% decrease since January 2012. Commercial waste diversion for the month of February 2012 is 30% which is a 3% decrease from January 2012.



FIRE PERMITS



Fire season starts April 1st and continues until October 31st. By-Law No. 1295-10 states that fire permits are required for burning during the fire season within municipal boundaries. The conditions of the By-Law shall be complied with and a Fire Permit shall be purchased.

With current weather conditions residents should be very cautious with any outdoor burning.
