BUILDING THIS YEAR

If you are thinking of building this year and require a Building Permit then you need to be aware that the Ontario Building Code is clear on what materials can be used.

Building materials allowed to be used in Ontario are listed in the Ontario Building Code but generally any material that has a ULC, CSA, CGA and CGSB rating (to name just a few) are the only materials allowed. These ratings assure us that the materials are approved and appropriate for their intended use.

The Ontario Building Code relies on these certifications for the grade and strength of dimensional lumber, strengths of plywoods and OSB, fire resistance rating and flame spread ratings and to ensure your windows and doors have the proper ratings for our northern climate.

The Municipal Building Inspector has the authority under the Ontario Building Code to not accept materials that are not approved for use in Ontario. Most building materials sold in Ontario are approved for use in Ontario. Material purchased from outside of Canada may not be approved for use in Ontario.

When you order your building package make sure to ask the supplier if the material is approved for use in Ontario. Or before you order your material and you come in to get a Building Permit ask the Building Inspector what materials are acceptable.
