SALE OF LOT BY PUBLIC TENDER

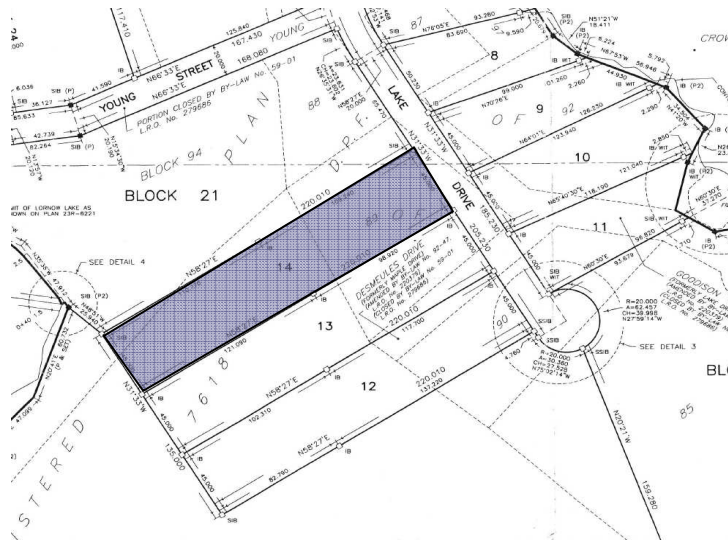
33 LAKE DRIVE, RED LAKE, ONTARIO
