## **ADOPT A CHILD OR FAMILY IS BACK AGAIN.....**

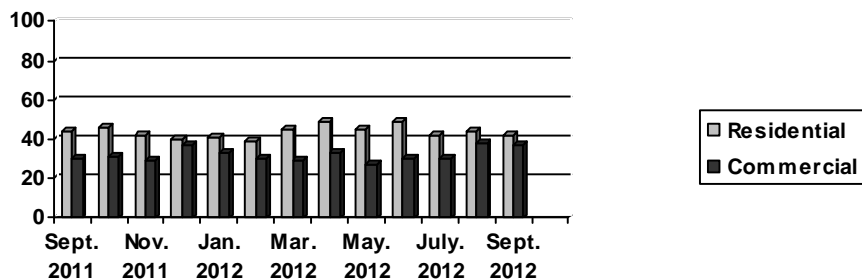
Christmas is getting close and it is time to make a wish come true for a child or a family in your community.

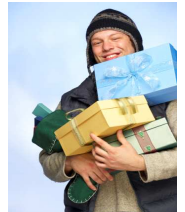
