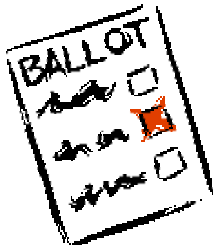

**VOTERS' LIST**

NOTICE is hereby given that I have complied with Section 23 of the *Municipal Elections Act, R.S.O., 1996*, and that I have available in my office at Balmertown, Ontario, the list of persons eligible to vote in the Municipality at Municipal Elections and the list remains there for inspection. I hereby call upon all Electors to examine the list and to take immediate proceedings to have any errors or omissions corrected according to law.

During the period September 2, 2003, to the close of voting on November 10, 2003, a person may make an application requesting that the person's name be added to or removed from or amended on the Voters' List.

Revisions to the list will be undertaken in the Municipality of Red Lake Municipal Office, Fifth Street, Balmertown, Ontario, during normal office hours Tuesday, September 2, 2003, through to Friday, November 7, 2003, after which additions may be made at the voting place.

**QUALIFICATIONS OF ELECTORS**

A person is entitled to be an Elector at an election held in a local municipality if on Voting Day, Monday, November 10, 2003, he or she:

- (a) resides in the local municipality or is the owner or tenant of land there, or the spouse or same-sex partner of such owner or tenant;
- (b) is a Canadian Citizen;
- (c) is at least 18 years old; and
- (d) is not disqualified under this or any other Act.

**PROXY VOTING**

Applications for proxy voting will be received in the Office of the Clerk during normal office hours (8:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.) and from 12:00 noon – 5:00 p.m. on November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2003. Application forms are available at the Municipal Office in Balmertown.

**ELECTION RESULTS**

Results will be announced and displayed in the Municipality of Red Lake Municipal Office at Lassie Road and Fifth Street in Balmertown on the evening of Monday, November 10<sup>th</sup>, 2003, as results are compiled.

Applicants appointed must be prepared to attend a training session for election workers, scheduled for October 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2003, @ 2:30 p.m. or 6:00 p.m.
