Message to the Residents of the Municipality of Red Lake Regarding the Heritage Centre's Deaccessioning Process

As recently indicated in the media, the Red Lake Regional Heritage Centre is deaccessioning over 300 items from its collection. These objects are being removed from the permanent collection for one of the following reasons: not relevant to the history of the area; minimal value or significance to the collection; poor condition; duplication; lack of documentation; and lack of storage/display space.

Deaccessioning these items will allow us to create space for new acquisitions that meet our Collections Policy and best represent the history of the community.

RLRHC's Board of Directors wants to reassure the public that the process followed by RLRHC for deaccessioning and disposing of these items is the ethical process followed by all museums in accordance with legislation (Revenue Canada) and the Canadian Museums Association Ethical Guidelines.

RLRHC's Collections Policy, which has been approved by the Ministry of Culture, Tourism and Sport, states that deaccessioned objects must be disposed of in the following order with the priority given to keeping donated objects in the public domain:

1. Transferred to the Education Collection
2. Exchanged or donated to another museum or charity
3. Repatriated
4. Sold at a public or silent auction (only if funds gained go into an account for collections development)
5. Physically destroyed.

Steps #1 – 3 have been completed and we are now at Step #4. The remaining items are being offered through public auction to prevent their physical destruction.

Bear Encounters – Who Do I Call?

Black bears that come into a populated area aren't always a threat to public safety. Below please find who to contact about encounters with black bears.

Emergency Situations

Call 911 if a black bear poses an immediate threat to personal safety by exhibiting threatening or aggressive behaviour, such as:

- Entering a school yard when school is in session
- Stalking people and is lingering at the site
- Entering or trying to enter a residence
- Wandering into a public gathering
- Killing livestock/pets and is lingering at the site



Non-Emergency Encounters

Call the toll-free Bear Wise reporting line at 1-866-514-2327 (TTY 705-945-7641) if a black bear is:

- In a tree
- Pulling down a bird feeder or knocking over a barbecue
- Moving through a backyard or field but is not lingering

This line operates 24 hours a day, seven days a week from April 1st until November 30th.
