DUE DATE PROPERTY TAXES – FINAL INSTALLMENT

The final installment for property taxes is due Friday, October 31st, 2003.

Payments may be made at the Municipal Office in Balmertown by way of interac, cheque, cash or credit card. Payments may also be made by mail, post-dated cheque or at the CIBC or the Bank of Nova Scotia and can be made in person, telebanking or internet banking. Payments must be received in the Municipal Office on or before the due date. Penalty for non-payment or late payment will be charged at 1.25% per month on the 1st day of each month. Please note that if a receipt is required for payments which are received by mail, a self-addressed stamped envelope must be included with your payment.

STREET PARKING – SNOW REMOVAL

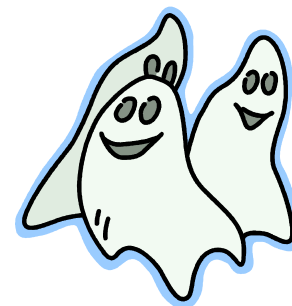
