Job Description: The intern's primary role will be to catalogue objects and archival material related to Red Lake's mining history. Other duties will include assisting with the day-to-day activities of the Heritage Centre such as conducting tours, fundraising, marketing, hospitality, etc.

Qualifications: The ideal candidate will be a recent graduate of the Museum Management and Curatorship program from an Ontario college or university, and will possess the following qualities/skills: excellent computer, communication, time-management and organizational skills and an ability to work independently and as part of a team. Recent graduates in Fine Arts, Canadian History, Arts Management and other programs related to arts and heritage will also be considered.
