Attention Dog Owners

By-Law No. 883-07 states that **no persons shall suffer, allow or permit any dog, of which he/she is the owner to run at large within the limits of the Municipality of Red Lake.** Be advised that failure to adhere to this By-Law may result in the set fine of **\$100.00** and possible pound fees if applicable.

Also, By-Law No. 883-07 states that **no person shall own a dog without obtaining a license as required by the By-Law and every owner shall be subject to the provisions of this By-Law.**

If you require a dog license the costs are as follows:

- For each spayed/neutered dog owned is \$15.00
- For each non-spayed/non-neutered dog owned is \$30.00
- For each additional dog owned in excess of two is \$100.00



Dog licenses are available at the Municipal Office. Be advised that failure to license may result in the set fine of **\$50.00 per dog** being issued.
