## **FILING OF NOMINATIONS – 2014 MUNICIPAL ELECTION**

(Preliminary Notice is hereby given to anyone proposing to be a candidate in the Municipal Election on October 27<sup>th</sup>, 2014.)

Section 33(1) of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*, provides that a person may be nominated for an office by filing a nomination with the Returning Officer in the Municipal Clerk's Office in person or by an agent. The nomination shall be in the prescribed form; be accompanied by a declaration of qualification in the prescribed form, signed by the person being nominated (facsimile signatures are not acceptable) and be accompanied by the prescribed nomination filing fee of \$200.00 for the office of Mayor or \$100.00 for all other offices. The filing fee is payable by cash, debit card, certified cheque or money order.

The Nomination Form may be filed with the Clerk at any time during normal office hours beginning Thursday, January 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2014, up to and including Thursday, September 11<sup>th</sup>, 2014 between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., and on Nomination Day – Friday, September 12<sup>th</sup>, 2014, between the prescribed hours of 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m.

### **Red Lake Library - Food for Fines**

For the month of December, library patrons can have overdue fines erased as the Red Lake Library holds the 9<sup>th</sup> Annual "Food for Fines", benefiting the Red Lake Homeless Shelter.

Library patrons may bring in non-perishable food items, hygiene items, or gently used winter wear to the Red Lake Library and their fines will be cleared. Fines for all materials (books, audios, movies) are eligible. The only exceptions are lost and damaged materials.

#### **Guidelines:**

- Only non-perishable, undamaged, unexpired labeled items will be accepted.
- All items must carry their original packaging.
- Home-canned or home-prepared foods cannot be accepted.
