PASSING OF BY-LAWS

The Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake passed the following By-Laws at the Regular Council Meeting held on Tuesday, April 22nd, 2014:

By-Law No. 1877-14 – Being a By-Law to Regulate the Keeping of Dogs in the Municipality of Red Lake; and

By-Law No. 1883-14 - Being a By-Law to Establish Policies with respect to the Sale and other Disposition of Land.

SNOW AND ICE REMOVAL BY-LAW – PROPOSED AMENDMENT

At the Regular Council Meeting held on Tuesday, April 22nd, 2014, an amendment (By-Law No. 1884-14) to the Snow and Ice By-Law regarding the depositing of snow and ice on municipal and private property was **defeated**.

Poop & Scoop

No owner shall suffer, allow or permit his/her dog to defecate on private or public property without immediate removal. **Failure to adhere to this section of the By-Law may result in a fine.**

Yard Maintenance

By-Law No. 902-07 (as amended) states the following:

- **No owner and/or occupant of Land shall fail to keep the Land clean and free from Debris.**
- **No owner and/or occupant of Land shall fail to keep the grass and/or weeds upon the Land trimmed so as not to exceed 20 cm in height.**

BEAR ENCOUNTERS – WHO DO I CALL?

Black bears that come into a populated area aren't always a threat to public safety. Below please find who to contact about encounters with black bears.

Emergency Situations

Call 911 if a black bear poses an immediate threat to personal safety by exhibiting threatening or aggressive behavior, such as:

- Entering a school yard when school is in session.
- Stalking people and is lingering at the site.
- Entering or trying to enter a residence.
- Wandering into a public gathering.
- Killing livestock/pets and is lingering at the site.



Non-Emergency Encounters

Call the toll-free Bear Wise reporting line at 1-866-514-2327 (TTY 705-945-7641) if a black bear is:

- In a tree
- Pulling down a bird feeder or knocking over a barbecue
- Moving through a backyard or field but is not lingering

This line operates 24 hours a day, seven days a week from April 1st until November 30th.
