FILING OF NOMINATIONS – 2014 MUNICIPAL ELECTION

(Notice is hereby given to anyone proposing to be a candidate in the Municipal Election on October 27, 2014)

Section 33(1) of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996, provides that a person may be nominated for an office by filing a nomination with the Returning Officer in the Municipal Clerk's Office in person or by an agent. The nomination shall be in the prescribed form; be accompanied by a declaration of qualification in the prescribed form, signed by the person being nominated (facsimile signatures are not acceptable) and be accompanied by the prescribed nomination filing fee of \$200.00 for the office of Mayor or \$100.00 for all other offices. The filing fee is payable by cash, debit card, certified cheque or money order. (Credit card payment **will not** be accepted.)

The Nomination Form may be filed with the Clerk at any time during normal office hours beginning Thursday, January 2nd, 2014, up to and including Thursday, September 11th, 2014 between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., and on Nomination Day – Friday, September 12th, 2014, between the prescribed hours of 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. for the following offices:

Kenora Catholic District School Board: **TRUSTEE (1)**

Qualifications – Elector/Mayor/Council

A person is entitled to be an elector and run for office if they are not disqualified by any Act or Law and on **Voting Day** they are:

- A resident of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake; or
- A non-resident who is an owner or tenant of land in the Municipality or the spouse or same sex partner of such owner or tenant; **and**
- A Canadian Citizen; **and**
- Of the full age of 18 years old.

Qualifications – School Board Trustee

A candidate for school trustee must, upon nomination, be a qualified municipal elector and fulfill all of the following requirements:

- A resident within the jurisdiction of the board;
- A supporter of the board;
- A Canadian Citizen;
- At least 18 years old;
- Roman Catholic (if running for a separate school board);
- Not legally prohibited from voting; **and**
- Not disqualified by any legislation from holding school board office.

VOTE-BY-MAIL FOR THE 2014 MUNICIPAL ELECTION

The Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake passed By-Law No. 1847-14 at a Regular Meeting of Council held Monday, January 20th, 2014, to authorize Vote by Mail as the method of voting for the 2014 Municipal Elections. Electronic tabulators were used in the 2010 Municipal Election for counting of ballots. Due to the increased costs for the rental of electronic tabulators, ballots will be counted by manual count.

HOW DOES VOTE BY MAIL WORK

Each elector will receive a ballot kit in the mail from Canada Post (replacement kits will be issued from the Revision Centre, located in the Municipal Office). Instructions will be included in the ballot kit.

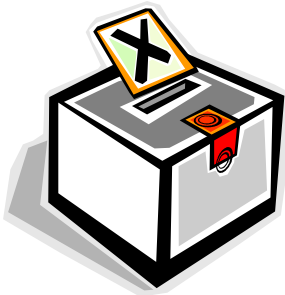

ARE YOU ON THE VOTER'S LIST?

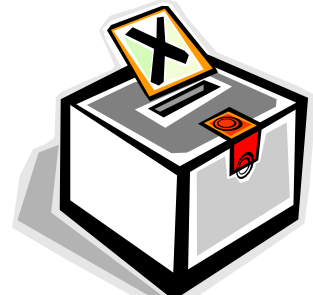
We encourage everyone to become an active participant in the upcoming election, be it as a candidate, eligible voter or interested observer.
