**5 Year Review of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake's
Official Plan & Zoning By-Law**

TAKE NOTICE that The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake (herein referred to as 'MORL') is undertaking the legislated five year review of its Official Plan and Zoning By-Law as required by the *Planning Act*. The purpose of this review is to ensure the currency of the Official Plan and the Zoning By-Law and to ensure that the documents remain consistent with provincial policy.

AND TAKE NOTICE that the Planning Advisory Committee of the MORL will hold a special meeting on the date, and at the time and place shown below, in accordance with *Section 26* of the *Planning Act* to consider recommending an Official Plan update as part of the Municipality's Five Year Review of the Official Plan. The MORL will consider a decision regarding the application at their regular meeting following this public meeting or at a special meeting (which shall be advertised as per the Notice By-Law).

ANY PERSON may attend the public meeting and/or make written or verbal representation either in support of, or in opposition to the proposed Official Plan and Zoning By-Law updates.

IF you wish to be notified of the adoption of the proposed Official Plan amendment or the Zoning By-Law you must make a written request to The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake at the address below.

IF a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the MORL before the proposed Official Plan amendment is adopted or the Zoning By-Law is approved, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing to the Ontario Municipal Board.

IF a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the MORL before the proposed Official Plan amendment is adopted or the Zoning By-Law is approved, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Municipal Board unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or public body.
