## SKATING SEASON

As most residents are aware, the Change Room for the outdoor rink in Balmertown was destroyed by fire during the morning of November 9<sup>th</sup>, 2003. The Municipality is in the process of investigating it's options with the building and will be deciding in the near future on what type of structure should be constructed to replace the destroyed building. The ice surface will be flooded in the near future and benches installed by the rink for all users of the facility. Due to winter being upon us, the new structure may not be constructed in time for the outdoor skating season.

The Municipality apologizes to the residents and especially the children who use this facility, for any inconvenience this may cause. If the weather continues to co-operate, the Red Lake outdoor rink will be open shortly and will be open 7 days a week. The Cochenour Arena also has public skating scheduled on Fridays and Sundays. Please check the weekly schedule as scheduled time slots may be changed or canceled due to special events, or there may also be additional public skating times added to the schedule.
